While he was here it was a blessing to see him connect with some former students of his who are now in Okinawa. It really shows the global impact of M516 as students and their families who were ministered to by Ryan stateside, end up all over the world. Ryan brought a powerful word to our youth ministry here. To see some kids turn to the book of Acts for the first time in their life was sobering. The pastor's wife translated his message into Japanese as he gave a clear and bold message about choosing to surrender ALL to Christ.

Ryan's time here flew by too quickly. We experienced so many wonderful foods and cultural things together. But honestly, the best part of his trip was just the time together in fellowship. It brought so much peace and vision for ministry that we've been needing. My six year old son who is special needs (autistic, non-verbal) is still asking for Ryan! He clearly ministered to every member of my family!
